



Child Life Specialists

Our child life department is comprised of over 60 child life specialists. The majority of our team is based at our two Primary Children's Hospital campuses in Salt Lake City and Lehi, the only freestanding children's hospitals in the Intermountain Health system. Our team also is based in 7 community hospitals throughout Utah.

Primary Children's Hospital serves one of the largest geographic areas of any children's hospital, including Utah, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, Wyoming, and Alaska, providing care for more than 1 million children living in a 400,000 square-mile service area. The Forever Young Zone inpatient playroom, sibling playroom, Seacrest Studios, and Sophie's Place music room are highlights for patients and families to participate in expressive activities and play experiences during their stay.

Our child life department is part of the family support services department. We work as a team to engage patients and families with therapeutic activities, positive distractions, and social support. We recently implemented an Adaptive Care Program that will be utilized throughout the entire Intermountain system. Monthly education opportunities to earn PDU's are also offered through the department.


